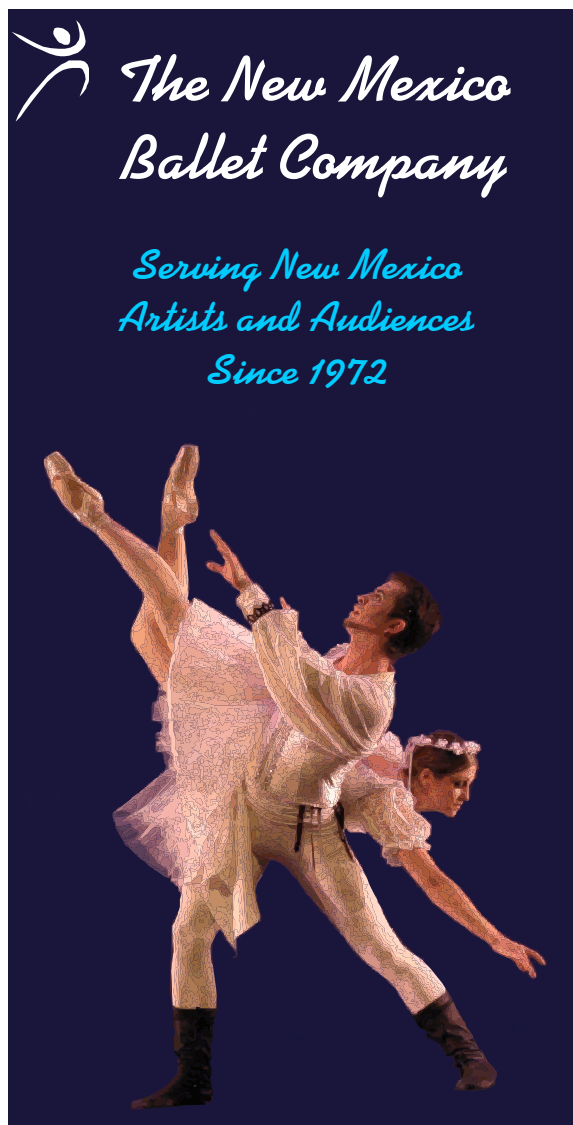

## **Admission Policies**

Auditions are not required for admission. Placement class will be held the first day of classes. Class placement will be determined by the Artistic Director and professional staff and be posted after classes in both technique and pointe. Dancers who do not attend the first week will be placed by Artistic Director at her discretion and may be moved after an initial class evaluation.

Class sizes will be limited and admission is on a first come, first serve basis. Drop-ins for individual classes will be allowed if the class is not full.

Our Youth section is new this year and will require a minimum of 10 full time students to maintain the class.

Men's classes will be available if enrollment allows. Please contact us for prices.

## **Curriculum**

The intensive is set up to provide students with high quality, intense training to keep the dancers in shape for the upcoming fall season. Each day for the intermediate and advanced levels, will include a one hour 45 minute technique class followed by one hour of pointe. There will be a short break followed by 75 minutes of either variation on pointe or a flexibility/strength or health class. The Youth level will have one hour 45 minutes of technique followed by one hour of pre-pointe preparation. There will be a short break followed by 75 minutes of either variation on flat or a flexibility/strength or health class.

<p>Please note: pre-pointe class is in no way an acknowledgement we consider your dancer ready for pointe. It is a class to help your dancer gain the strength needed for pointe and have an understanding of what pointe involves. Placement into a pointe class will be determined by your home studio.</p>

Breaks between classes are very short and there is only a 45 minute lunch break. Be sure to send plenty of water and light, healthy compact snacks for your dancer each day.

## **Housing**

Home stay housing is available for non-local dancers. Please contact NMBC for information. There might be an additional fee for home stays. If we have enough interest, housing at a local hotel might be arranged with an adult chaperone. All costs will be the responsibility of the dancer and their parent and is only available for age 13 and above female students.

## **Notification of Changes**

NMBC reserves the right to change faculty, staff or times listed here. While we do not anticipate changes, they may occur. Updates will be given to registered dancers as they happen. Please check in at the web site to see all changes.

## **Registration**
